Reckitt Benckiser and Dettol 'Gyan Jyothi' Scholarship - 2009

This Scheme is instituted by Reckitt Benckiser, makers of Dettol to recognize and reward young Indian students in Sitarganj town (Uttarakhand) with outstanding track record in studies (any streams – Science, Arts and Commerce).

OBJECTIVES:

The aim is to reward Young Achievers (< 21 years) who have displayed a potential for higher studies with very good track record.

ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY POINTS:

i) The Award is open to Indian Nationals, residing in Sitarganj (Uttarakhand), who are below the **age of 21 years**.

ii) Scholarships will be given for two classes and have been named as under -

RB 11 - 11th Class Scholarship

RB 12 - 12th Class Scholarship

iii) Details of RB 11 – Students enrolled in 11th Standard (any stream – science, arts or commerce) during the academic year 2009 – 2010 are entitled to apply for this scholarship. Students must have secured a minimum of 60% marks (50% for SC/ST) marks in Aggregate (Total %) in 10th Standard Board Exams. Additional weightage will be given to students who have scored high (above 60%) in Science and Maths in 10th Standard Board Exams.

A total of 25 scholarships will be awarded through the RB 11 program

iv) Details of RB 12 – Students enrolled in 12th Standard (any stream – science, arts or commerce) during the academic year 2009 – 2010 are entitled to apply for this scholarship. Students must have secured a minimum of 60% marks (50% for SC/ST) marks in Aggregate (Total %) in **10th Standard Board Exams**. Additional weightage will be given to students who have scored high (above 60%) in standard 11th exams in terms of aggregate (Total %) as per report card/mark sheet from institute/university.

A total of 25 scholarships will be awarded through the RB 12 program

ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT:

i) RB 11 - 11th Class Scholarship will entail the annual tuition fees of 11th Standard for one entire year. The amount will be paid to the Student in one/full final payment as reimbursement of the fees paid to the institute. In case the fees has been paid on quarterly basis – reimbursement of quarters paid will be made to the student and for the rest of the quarters will be paid directly through Demand Draft (DD) or cheque in the name of the institute of the remaining amount done for the year.

ii) RB 12 - 12th Class Scholarship will entail the annual tuition fees of 12th Standard. The amount will be paid to the Student in one/full final payment as reimbursement of the fees paid to the institute. In case the fees has been paid on quarterly basis – reimbursement of quarters paid will be made to the student and for the rest of the quarters will be paid directly through Demand Draft (DD) or cheque in the name of the institute of the remaining amount done for the year.

DURATION:

The duration of the scholarship will be for ONE year

Annual renewal (from Standard 11th to 12th Standard) will not be automatic
